WHAT IS DISNEY GRAD NITE?

Disney Grad Nite is a 39 year-old tradition at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort that brings together high school seniors from across the country for a once-in-a-lifetime experience. This all night celebration at the *Magic Kingdom*® Park features performances by chart-topping performing artists, world famous attractions, multiple themed dance parties, a customized fireworks show, and more.

Disney Grad Nite 2011 April 29, April 30, May 6, & May 7 10:00 pm – 4:00 am

Taio Cruz and **3OH!3** will take the stage at *Disney Grad Nite* to perform for the Class of 2011. Seniors can enjoy *Magic Kingdom* Park attractions like *Space Mountain*®, *The Haunted Mansion*, *Pirates of The Caribbean*, and *Splash Mountain*. **DJ Pauly D** will be making appearances throughout the night at *Dancing in the Streets Parties*. This year's event will also have multiple themed dance parties, including the *Silent Groove* where you can dance to music heard through headphones from one of 2 DJ's spinning your favorite songs. Seniors will also get to enjoy a special fireworks show, created just for the Class of 2011.

PRE-GRAD NITE BLAST-OFF! PARTY

Groups who purchase a special priced pre-party ticket can enter *Magic Kingdom*® Park early and enjoy the Pre-Grad Nite *Blast-Off!* Party from 8:00 pm – 10:00 pm.

The *Blast-Off!* Party allows seniors to enjoy the park attractions and dance parties early before the concerts begin. The 2011 pre-party ticket includes a meal coupon that is valid for (1) entrée, (1) side dish (if not included with entrée), (1) drink, and (1) dessert at participating restaurants.

HOW TO RESERVE

Contact your Student Travel Planner or complete the form and **fax it to (407) 566-7688** or visit www.disneygradnite.com to complete the form online. By completing this form, you are simply reserving your date to attend and letting us know that you wish to receive Grad Nite posters and promotional material. Also, if you are using a Student Travel Planner, please note on the Reservation Form.

TRANSPORTATION

All groups must arrange their own transportation to and from all *Disney Grad Nite* events. Existing Disney Transportation will not be available for Grad Nite guests*. Vehicles must be driven by a bus driver or chaperone. (*Student driven vehicles are not permitted.*)

It is recommended that event tickets be distributed to each student and chaperone before leaving your school. Please also make sure that everyone in your group is aware of where your transportation will be parked at the end of the event. This location will be given to you upon arrival.

The Florida Department of Transportation may conduct motor carrier inspections of all vehicles on site during the event. Please advise your motor coach company and prepare accordingly.

Motor Coach Transportation

- Please do not arrive more than ½ hour before the start of your event in the *Magic Kingdom*® Park.
- Once you arrive on *Walt Disney World*® Resort property for the event, follow signs to *Magic Kingdom*.
- As you approach the *Magic Kingdom* toll plaza, signs will direct buses through a designated lane.
- A Disney Host/Hostess will direct you to the appropriate drop-off area.
- Buses will relocate to Ticket and Transportation Center parking after group drop-off.
- Bus drivers will have a lounge at the Ticket and Transportation Center during the event. To gain admittance to the event, bus drivers will need a chaperone ticket.
- At the end of the event, attendees will take Disney Transportation to the Ticket and Transportation Center and must then locate their bus (location given to you upon arrival).

Personal Vehicles

- Please do not arrive more than ½ hour before the start of your event in the *Magic Kingdom* Park.
- Once you arrive on *Walt Disney World* Resort property for the event, follow signs to *Magic Kingdom*.
- Once you have approached the *Magic Kingdom* toll plaza, a Disney Host/Hostess will direct you to the designated parking area.
- Once parked, attendees will take Disney Transportation to *Magic Kingdom*.
- At the end of the event, attendees will take Disney Transportation to the Ticket and Transportation Center and must then locate their vehicles.

CHAPERONE INFORMATION & BENEFITS

Chaperones are any adults (over 21 years old) who take an active part in accompanying the group to *Disney Grad Nite*. We will provide 1 complimentary chaperone ticket per 10 student tickets purchased. Please designate a Head Chaperone who will lead the trip, serve as the main contact for the group, and disseminate information in the handbook to all chaperones.

Chaperones are vital to the success of Grad Nite. We know that adult visibility helps make this event more enjoyable for everyone attending. Here are some things to keep in mind before and during the event:

- The Head Chaperone must provide their cell phone number to be used during the event. Please email wdw.disney.grad.nite@disney.com with the subject line "School Name-Head Chaperone Contact Information"
- Chaperones must keep their Grad Nite ticket (marked "Chaperone" on back) with them for the entire event and must wear their chaperone credential at all times. Chaperone credentials will be distributed to groups before the event.
- Each group must have an "on duty" chaperone who can field any student questions or needs. We suggest that on-duty chaperones reside at Chaperone Headquarters during their shift.
- Please review the information in the Chaperone Handbook for more chaperone information and the location of the Chaperone Headquarters.
- Communicate event details to both students such as dress code and other important details as noted in the Chaperone Handbook.

DINING OPTIONS

Disney Youth Dining Options can be ordered when you or your Student Travel Planner submit your ticket order online or by fax.

Disney Youth Group Meal Coupons – Valid for use at participating restaurants located within the *Walt Disney World*® Resort.

- **Breakfast Meal Coupon**- Includes choice of one (1) of the following: One (1) breakfast platter (not valid for steak and eggs platter), and one (1) single-serving nonalcoholic beverage, **OR** one (1) bakery item, one (1) side dish, and one (1) single-serving non-alcoholic beverage.
- **Lunch/Dinner Meal Coupon**- Includes choice of one (1) of the following: One (1) combo meal (entree, side dish and single-serving non-alcoholic beverage), and one (1) dessert **OR** one (1) entree, one (1) side dish (if not included in entree), and one (1) single-serving non-alcoholic beverage.

Disney Dining Cards

- This flexible dining card is available in any dollar value from \$5 to \$1,500. Use this card at most food and beverage locations throughout *Walt Disney World* Resort, including some outdoor food and snack carts. Each time the card is used to make a food purchase, that exact purchase amount is removed from the remaining balance on the card.

DRESS CODE

Disney Grad Nite is no ordinary day in the park. Everyone, including chaperones, attending this party needs to be dressed to impress. Below is our dress code policy. *Please note that your school may enforce a stricter dress code.*

<p>Controlled Substances/Medication</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asthma inhalers • Cough drops • Contact solution, eye drops, hand sanitizers smaller than 4oz. (120mL) • Contraceptives (birth control pills, etc.) • Epinephrine (EPI Pens) • Prescription medication with completed medical form • Insulin/Syringes (need to be inspected at nurses station)
