## Wagon Guidelines

The most desirable wagons used at Kosair Children's Hospital are those that maintain the original wagon structure and are attractively painted. However, if you choose to decorate or modify the wagon, please adhere to the guidelines below.

1. Materials must be able to be cleaned with a hospital approved disinfectant. No fabric of any kind is allowed on the wagons due to the inability to clean these products.
2. Decorations or modifications placed on wagons must be able to be cleaned with a hospital approved disinfectant and **must maintain overall integrity of the wagon structure**. Decorations/modifications must be large enough not to pose a choking or strangulation hazard, and should be securely fastened.
3. Ropes or any type of string cannot be placed on the wagons, due to the risk of choking or strangulation.
4. If wood is used on the wagons it must be sanded to a smooth surface and sealed or covered with a barrier.

***Please be advised that if wagon guidelines are not followed or if Kosair Children's Hospital deems the wagon unsafe; the Children's Hospital Foundation reserves the right to use the wagons outside of the hospital for other purposes.***
